What's New in DEVONthink To Go 4.0

Generative AI Integration

DEVONthink To Go now includes generative AI capabilities to help you summarize documents, generate ideas, or even draft content. Whether you're reviewing research or brainstorming, AI is here to assist you — right within the app. Use your favorite AI model via API key or, if you don't want to let AI into your workflow, just don't enter one at all.

Custom Metadata

Add your own metadata fields to documents, making [it](#) easier to categorize and filter your collection. Whether [it's](#) a [project](#) status, priority levels, or the author names, you can tailor DEVONthink To Go to fit your workflow.

Versioning

Never lose track of changes. Versioning allows you to view and restore previous versions of your documents. Let [it](#) work automatically for you in the background or create versions manually when you've reached an important stage.

Smart Groups

Let DEVONthink To Go do the organizing for you. Smart Groups automatically gather documents based on criteria you define like tags, metadata, or search terms. Your documents are always there when you need them.
